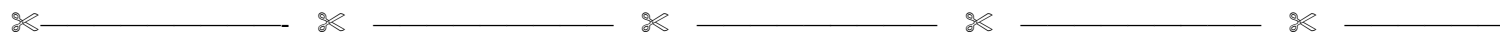
### HOUSING CONTRACT & PAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS

### 1. PARTIES

The parties to this Contract are the Regents of the University of California, hereinafter called "University," and the undersigned student, hereinafter called "Resident."

### 2. TERM

The term of this Contract shall be for Summer Session 2009, and the dates of occupancy shall be as specified in the UC San Diego Housing Calendar (Appendix A) which is incorporated into and made part of this Contract. By signing this Contract, Resident agrees to be bound for the entire term of this Contract.

### 3. ROOM AND BOARD

Room and board fees are due upon returning a complete signed Contract. Rates and dates are specified in UC San Diego Housing Calendar, Costs, and Fees (Appendix A).

### 4. THE UNIVERSITY SHALL

- a. Provide Resident with furnished single, double or triple room occupancy within a UC San Diego On-Campus Housing facility for the term of this Contract. Resident will be assigned to a specific room, not necessarily in his/her college of registration.
- b. Provide Resident with a Dining Plan as described in Appendix A, which is incorporated into and made part of this Contract. The Dining Plan Dollars are deposited at the beginning of the term of this Contract and expire at the end of the term of this Contract. The Dining Plan cannot be changed to a lesser value, transferred, dropped, carried forward or refunded. For ultimate convenience, Resident's Dining Plan is linked to the student Campus ID Card and individually coded as identification for authorized access to any designated available HDH dining facility during Summer Session 2009. Each purchase is automatically deducted from your account balance – just like a bank debit card. For information regarding HDH dining, please refer to the website at <http://hds.ucsd.edu/diningservices>. The first Contract meal begins with dinner on the first day of the term of this Contract and ends with dinner on the last day of the term of this Contract.
- c. Reserve the sole right during the term of this Contract to assign and move Resident to another room or a temporary space, or to assign additional residents to any room, or reduce the number of residents per room or suite as permanent space becomes available anywhere within UC San Diego Housing facilities. The terms and conditions set forth herein are applicable to all room types occupied by one, two or three residents.
- d. Assign roommates based on the information provided on the Personal History Form, without regard to race, religion, national origin, or sexual orientation, and does not guarantee a specific room or roommates. Apartment rooms will be assigned on a single-sex basis.
- e. Provide weekly cleaning services for common areas of the Apartment or Residence Hall-Style units. For detailed information, please refer to the website at <http://hdh.ucsd.edu/maintenance/>.
- f. Provide water, gas and electricity, trash removal, on-site laundry facility, cable TV service and in-room computing services as stated in the Residential Networking Policy, which is incorporated herein by reference. For detailed information, please refer to the website at <http://resnet/policies.shtml>.

### 5. THE RESIDENT SHALL

- a. Be a single, enrolled UC San Diego Summer Session student as defined by the Summer Session Office, for the term of this Contract or a single, registered undergraduate UC San Diego student as defined by the Registrar's Office, for the term of this Contract.
- b. If under 18 years of age, have the parent or appointed guardian agree to the terms, sign this Contract and guarantee the full and prompt payment of all sums payable by Resident under this Contract. *Please print the PDF file of this Contract.*

Return the completed and signed Contract by mail or in person to the Housing Dining Hospitality (HDH) Administrative Services Office. No faxes accepted.

- c. Pursuant to California Law, if Resident passes a check or E-check payment of insufficient funds, Resident will be liable to University for the amount of the check plus a service charge of \$35. Payments are always applied to the oldest student housing charges and fees first, and then to the more recent charges.
- d. Agree that there will be no proration of room and board for the first and the last week of each term, should Resident decide to move in later or move out earlier during these specific periods.
- e. Abide by the move-in and move-out procedures through the College Residential Life Office as defined by the UC San Diego Housing Calendar (Appendix A). If Resident cannot move in by the specified move-in dates, Resident agrees to furnish written notice of late arrival to the College Residential Life Office prior to University's specified move-in days.
- f. Be permitted to change to another room only with prior approval from the HDH Administrative Services and the College Residential Life Office.
- g. Not change, move, modify, or alter the room, its furnishings, fixtures, equipment or decorations without prior written consent of the College Residential Life Office.
- h. Not assign this Contract or sublease the room, or use it in any manner other than as a personal residence.
- i. Under no circumstances permit any guest(s) to use the room without prior written consent from University.
- j. Not conduct business or commercial enterprise of any kind including e-business in any UC San Diego HDH facility.
- k. Not have pets or any animals, except for fish which are kept in an aquarium that does not exceed 10 gallons. Requests for aquariums must be approved by the College Residential Life Office and must have a concurrence of all roommates prior to set-up.
- l. Abide by the rules and regulations of UC San Diego On-Campus Housing, the Residential Life Office, and all applicable state and federal laws, which are incorporated herein by reference. Rules and regulations are listed in the Residential Networking Policy, the Residential Life Student Handbook available from each of the Residential Life Offices or online, and the UCSD Policies and Procedures Applying to Student Activities, found at [http://ugr8.ucsd.edu/judicial/tblcontents\\_src.html](http://ugr8.ucsd.edu/judicial/tblcontents_src.html). Violations of the rules and regulations may become the basis for action against Resident, which may include initiation of legal proceedings to terminate this Contract and/or exclusion from entering into a future housing contract.
- m. Not perform or arrange for non-UC San Diego staff to perform any repairs to damages or corrections of deficiencies in the premises, whether during or upon the termination of Resident's tenancy. The foregoing shall not limit Resident's right to request that University repair damage, correct deficiencies, or otherwise service the premises during tenancy. Notwithstanding such a request, Resident shall be liable for any damages done to the premises or deficiencies created by Resident, Resident's guests or invitees. Normal wear and tear is expected.
- n. Vacate the premises no later than 6:00 p.m. on the last day of the term of this Contract. Upon move-out, Resident agrees to leave the premises in the same condition as it was received, subject to normal wear and tear. Resident shall pay the University for costs to clean, repair, replace or rebuild any portion of the premises, furniture and fixtures damaged by the Resident, Resident's guests or invitees.

### 6. CONTRACT CANCELLATION

**(Prior to move-in dates or upon failure to take occupancy)**

- a. To cancel this Contract, Resident must notify HDH Administrative Services in writing, by fax or via email prior to move-in day. Cancellation of this Contract will be effective upon receipt of the request. Resident will be assessed a \$200 Cancellation Fee as specified in Appendix A, which is incorporated into and

made part of this Contract. Because it is impractical or extremely difficult to determine the actual damages, the parties agree that this Contract Cancellation Fee is presumed to be reasonable to cover the University's administrative costs resulting from the cancellation by Resident. This fee represents a reasonable endeavor by the University to estimate fair average compensation for any loss that may be sustained, and is accepted as the amount of liquidated damages.

- b. Failure to cancel the Contract or to move in during the specified dates will constitute a "No Show." The Contract will be cancelled and Resident will be charged a \$200 cancellation fee.

## 7. CONTRACT TERMINATION

### (After move-in date or after taking occupancy)

- a. Please note that this Contract is a legal and binding agreement. Contracts may not be broken mid-term except for the reasons listed below. All requests for termination of this Contract must be submitted in writing along with the appropriate supporting documents to the Resident's Residential Life Office. The Housing Contract Release Application is available at each College's Residential Life Office. If Resident is under 18 years of age, request for Contract Termination must be accompanied by a written consent of the parent or legal guardian. Upon authorization, the effective termination date will be the date of the University approval. Resident shall remain responsible for all room and board charges until the termination date.
- b. A \$100 Contract Termination Fee shall be paid by Resident. Because it is impractical or extremely difficult to determine the actual damages, the parties agree that this Contract Termination Fee is presumed to be reasonable to cover the University's administrative costs resulting from Resident vacating the room. This sum represents a reasonable endeavor by the University to estimate fair average compensation for any loss that may be sustained, and is accepted as the amount of liquidated damages.
- c. Contract Termination by the University:
1. Resident (international or visiting student) is not currently enrolled in Summer Session classes at the University of California, San Diego.
  2. Resident is ineligible for On-Campus Housing for singles as a result of marriage.
  3. Resident fails to disclose status that may prohibit him/her from single undergraduate On-Campus housing.
  4. Resident fails to make required payments in accordance with the Residential Housing Calendar, Costs and Fees (Appendix A).
  5. Resident fails to comply with this Contract, the rules and regulations (Section 5L), and all applicable federal and state laws, or otherwise engaging in behavior, activity or conduct which is detrimental to himself/herself or the welfare of others.
  6. The University may terminate this Contract and all attendant rights of occupancy without cause upon 30 days notice to the Resident. The Resident may be subject to a Three Day Notice to Perform Covenant or Quit, to Pay Room and Board or Quit, or a Notice to Quit, whichever is appropriate, under any circumstances allowed by law.
- d. Contract Termination by Resident:
1. Resident leaves the University due to graduation, withdrawal, dismissal, transfer or participation in a University-authorized and approved study abroad program. It is the Resident's responsibility to furnish the College Residential Life Office with evidence of dismissal from the University within 15 days of the effective date of dismissal.
  2. Resident becomes ineligible for On-campus Housing as a result of marriage and presents proof of such. This Contract will be terminated on the date that evidence is presented to the College Residential Life Office.
- e. Request for Contract termination other than reasons listed above will be reviewed on an individual basis.
- f. Resident is responsible for room and board fees until the request is approved. The Contract Termination Fee is in addition to any sums owed by Resident. Without a proper termination authorization, Resident must continue to pay all fees until the end of the contract term.
- g. In all cases, Resident shall be eligible for a refund of room and board charges paid beyond the effective termination date, less Termination Fee, any **Dining Plan over usage**, and any additional custodial-related charges associated with the period of residency. (Refer to Dining Budget Calendar at <http://hdh.ucsd.edu/diningservices/images/DiningDollarsBudget.pdf>.)

- h. Resident must return the keys to the Residential Life Office. Proper move-out procedures must be completed; simply moving out or turning in the keys does not constitute termination of this Contract or release resident from contractual obligations.

## 8. IT IS FURTHER AGREED THAT

- a. University personnel or those contracted by University may, after 24-hours notice, enter Resident's room during normal working hours to show it to a prospective tenant, pursuant to a Court Order, or for cleaning, maintenance, or repairs to ensure compliance with UC San Diego On-Campus Housing and Health and Safety Regulations as deemed necessary by University. Said notice is not required in the event of any emergency. Resident agrees to waive the 24-hour notice requirement to allow University personnel to enter Resident's room or apartment/residence hall during normal working hours when Resident has requested the service.
- b. It is a violation of this Contract, the Residential Life Student Handbook policies and the UCSD Policies and Procedures Applying to Student Activities to duplicate University keys and violators will be subject to disciplinary action. In the event of lost or misplaced non-electronic keys, and/or damaged electronic locks, the Resident agrees to pay the following:
1. Non-electronic Key - for front/main door the charge is \$100 through September 5, 2009, and \$120 thereafter.
  2. Non-electronic Key - for bedroom and mailbox the charge is \$6 through September 5, 2009, and \$10 thereafter.
  3. Electronic Lock - Intentionally tampering and damaging an electronic lock will result in charges up to \$450 for repair and/or replacement.
- c. Delinquency in payment is a violation of this Contract by Resident and may result in any or all of the following actions: a \$20 late fee assessment, administrative action against the Resident's status in University, restrictions or hold on records, and initiation of legal proceedings to terminate this Contract.
- d. Resident has inspected the premises, furnishings and equipment, and has found them to be satisfactory. All plumbing, heating and electrical systems are operative and deemed satisfactory. Defects and damages which are not reported at the time of possession on the College Room Inventory Form and are found after Resident vacates the unit shall be the sole expense of Resident and, if necessary, additional custodial-related charges associated with the period of tenancy will be billed to Resident's student account. Normal wear and tear is expected.
- e. The cost of any move, loss or damage to the facility or its fixtures, furnishings, equipment, or decorations shall be charged to Resident if either Resident or Resident's guest is the cause of such move, loss or damage. Such cost shall be determined by University at its sole discretion, and payment for such costs shall be made by Resident and is due upon receipt of the notice. In the event the cause of any loss or damage to the above-mentioned University properties cannot be determined after reasonable investigation by the University, the prorated cost of such move, loss or damage shall be charged to all residents in that area responsible for such properties, regardless of whether Resident was present at the time that the move, loss or damage occurred.
- f. If desired, Resident may request a preliminary inspection prior to vacating the premises. Such request must be made at least two (2) weeks prior to the last day of the Term of this Contract or, if applicable, prior to vacating the premises. The Resident may be present during the preliminary inspection if desired.
- g. University, its personnel, and those contracted by University assume no responsibility for the loss, theft, damage, or destruction to personal property kept in Resident's assigned room or any other location on the premises. University strongly recommends that Resident maintain personal property insurance on his/her belongings. Renter's insurance may be obtained from any insurance company of Resident's choice. University does not offer renter's insurance. Resident agrees that personal property left in the room or on the property after the expiration, cancellation or termination of this Contract shall be disposed in accordance with applicable state law.
- h. In the event of a vacancy in an assigned room/suite, University reserves the right to reassign Resident to another room or apartment to match with the remaining occupancy level.
- i. University may, at its sole discretion, increase the housing fees by up to five percent (5%) of total charges during the term of this Contract in the event of unusual and unforeseen circumstances. University shall serve written notification of the changes 30 days prior to the beginning of the session.

**9. BREACH OF CONTRACT**

In the event that Resident breaches this Contract, University shall be allowed at University's discretion, but not by way of limitation, to exercise any or all remedies provided by California Civil Code 1951.2.

**10. GROUP LIVING**

Each of the UC San Diego Residential Housing facilities is a group living situation, in which students are assigned rooms in residence halls and apartments shared with other students as roommates, suitemates, and apartment-mates. Resident shall not violate any criminal or civil law, ordinance or statute in the use and occupancy of premises, commit waste or nuisance, annoy, molest or interfere with any other Resident or neighbor. Any such action may result in the immediate termination of this Contract as provided herein and by law. Resident agrees to respect the rights of the other residents and to conduct himself/herself in a manner conducive to the harmonious group living environment developed and fostered by each College Residential Life Office. University may terminate this Contract if Resident demonstrates an ongoing inability to abide by the requirements and expectations for such group living. (Refer to the current Residential Life Student Handbook, which is incorporated herein by reference, for further information.)

**11. TELEPHONE SERVICE**

Pursuant to Civil Code section 1941.4, University is responsible for installing one useable telephone jack, and for placing and maintaining the inside telephone wiring in good working order in residential dwellings. Resident is responsible for the telephone and any wiring between the telephone and the telephone jack. If there is a problem with telephone service, Resident must first determine that the problem is not in the telephone or the wiring running to the telephone jack. Once it is determined that the problem is not in either the telephone or said wiring, Resident is required to notify the UC San Diego HDH Customer Service Center at (858)534-2600, and University will arrange for any necessary repair of the telephone jack or inside wiring. If Resident does not report such problems to University and incurs a cost arranging a repair, the University shall not be liable for reimbursement to Resident. If Resident chooses not to activate the in-room phone service, Resident must notify the College Residential Life Office and provide an alternate active phone number.

**12. MOLD NOTIFICATION**

Mold occurs naturally in the environment and there currently are no state or federal laws that define the amount or type of mold that is hazardous or that define the University's duties with respect to mold. Our goal is to maintain the highest quality living environment for our Residents. Resident is hereby notified that mold, however, can grow if the premises are not properly maintained or ventilated. Resident is required to keep the premises clean and well-ventilated, particularly when showering, bathing, or washing dishes or clothes. Resident is required to notify the HDH Customer Service Center promptly (within 24 hours) about the existence of water leakage or overflow in or about the premises.

**13. ABANDONMENT**

If the University determines that the premises have been abandoned, it may dispose of any property remaining on the

premises as allowed by law, and Resident shall be liable for any costs incurred by the University in disposing of such property, including, but not limited to storage costs. Abandonment does not relieve Resident's obligation to pay room and board costs.

**14. CONSTRUCTION AND RENOVATION**

Construction and/or remodeling or repair of academic, residential and dining buildings on the UC San Diego campus in the vicinity of the residence halls and apartments is scheduled for the 2009-10 Summer Session and Academic Year. Construction is expected to occur during normal daytime working hours, and will result in disturbances and disruptions, including, but not limited to, increased noise and dust in the area surrounding the residence halls and apartments. By signing this Contract, Resident agrees that he/she has been advised of said scheduled construction, and acknowledges that there will be disturbances and disruptions resulting from construction and has agreed to such.

**15. PARKING**

Parking availability is not guaranteed. Resident is responsible for adhering to all campus and housing regulations.

**16. NOTICE**

Pursuant to Section 290.46 of the Penal Code, information about specified registered sex offenders is made available to the public via an internet website maintained by the Department of Justice at <http://www.meganslaw.ca.gov/>. Depending on an offender's criminal history, this information will include either the address at which the offender resides, the community of residence or zip code in which he or she resides.

**17. ASSURANCE OF ACCOMMODATION**

Resident shall be assured of accommodations under this Contract only when Resident submits this Contract properly completed, signed, accompanied with the Personal History Form, Payment Coupon and the Full Payment of the session requested to the HDH Administrative Services Office, and when Resident receives a written confirmation letter via email from the HDH Administrative Services Office.

**18. WAIVER OF BREACH**

The waiver of either party of any breach shall not be construed to be a continuing waiver of any subsequent breach. The receipt by University of the room and board payment with the knowledge of any violation of a condition hereto shall not be deemed a waiver of such breach. No waiver by either party of the provisions herein shall be deemed to have been made unless expressed in writing and signed by all parties.

**19. CERTIFICATION**

Resident certifies that the statements made on the application and contract documents in connection with this Contract are true and correct. This Contract cannot be changed or modified. Falsification of these statements will render this Contract null and void. Resident has read and understands the terms and conditions of this Contract, all appendices, and other publications incorporated herein by reference.

*By signing this Contract, Resident acknowledges having read and understood the foregoing, including documents incorporated herein by reference, agrees to be bound by its terms, and acknowledges receipt of a duplicate of the original Contract.*
